DePonte Cellars Estate Vineyard was planted in 1975. It is one of the original vineyards planted in the Dundee Hills region of the Willamette Valley

Tasting Notes:

This wine is a representation of the distinctive Dundee Hills terroir. It exhibits aromas of violets, rose petals and toasted oak. Notes of plum, black cherries and raspberries follow with a hint of chocolate on the complex, silky palate, along with well integrated tannins. The grapes were gently hand sorted
