Vintage Notes: 2012 saw the first 'normal' bud break in two years, which was followed by a fabulous Oregon summer—dry, 80 degree sunny days paired with cool, crisp evenings. Harvest commenced in early October and yielded fruit that was full of flavor and color.

Tasting Notes: Intense nose of pineapple and exotic fruits that is accented by floral notes. A beautiful roundness on the palate offers fresh and juicy aromas supported by a nice, vivid acidity.

Food Pairings: Oregon Dungeness Crab, Netarts Bay Oysters and coconut shrimp.
