

In October of 2014 we trucked fruit down from Moonlight Vineyard in Walla Walla, Washington (adjacent to Abeja) and produced under 75 cases of our first Syrah.

The name Shot Put Syrah is in homage of Rick Baldwin, our owner Scott's older brother, and his prolific high school history in this unique and challenging sport.

100% of proceeds from Shot Put sales will go to Rick's ALS (Lou Gehrig's disease) Fund.

Dark, intense black cherry color. Smoky, mocha notes on the nose give way to accents of plum jam and warm ganache. The mouth feel is round and supported by powerful and fine grained tannins. The elegant and long finish is highlighted by notes of black licorice and wild blackberries off the vine. Drink now thru 2025.

Price is **\$57.30**, the length of Rick's championship throw of 57 feet, 3 inches.
